Ontario Eco Schools is a province wide organization that supports environmental initiatives in schools. St. Bernadette's has established an ECO team and students from Grades 1-6 participate over the lunch hour. This past month, we welcomed Michelle Rich from the Region of York. She shared an excellent presentation on waste management. Our students are encouraged to continue bringing lunches in reusable containers and boomeranging organic waste back home where it can be composted.

Thank you so much for your generosity over the last few weeks.


We will continue to sell the Ice Dawg sandwiches for \$2.00 until May 4th. All proceeds will be directed to ShareLife.
