

SCHOOL COUNCIL FUNDS

WHERE DID THE FUNDS GO?

This year we rasied a grand total of \$17,227.23 through various fundraising programs. The funds raised were used to pay for all the items listed below

- \$8,125.09 towards the Outdoor Classroom & Natural Playground
- \$747.38 towards renting risers for the Christmas Concert
- \$564.90 for a school Christmas Lunch
- \$500.00 for a new Bonnhome costume
- \$476.57 for a school Camera
- \$747.05 for a Digital Scoreboard
- \$131.79 for 2 Smartboard Pens
- \$650.00 towards the Grade 6 and SK Graduation
- \$951.00 towards new Athletic Equipment
- \$2048.00 towards new Chorme books and Technology
- \$700.00 for Mulch for the kindergarten yard
- \$100.00 towards a Benevolent Fund
- \$85.45 towards Student Support

• \$1400.00 towards a Sun Shade Gazebo for the Kindergarten Yard (Unfortunately we are not able to purchase the sun shade gazebo we voted on as the school board will not allow a residential unit to be placed in the yard. The funds for it will be disscussed again next year.)

PLUS we have received over \$5000.00 in nutrition grants and from the fresh from the farm fundrasier to continue our snack program for the students all year and to support the You're the Chef program.

KINDERGARTEN EXPANDSION

The Kindergarten yard was successfully completed at the start of the school year. The final amount paid for the renovation was \$6,090.90 from the funds raised last year and we will be adding another \$680.00 worth of fresh mulch before the end of the school year. PLANNING STAGE

We are currently working towards coming up with a plan for a FNMI Natrual Playground and design that meets the town and boards safety codes. Pictures above are just examples of the types of things we have been looking into and having priced out.

PHASE 1

Our goal is to add an outdoor classroom that serves as both a learning area but has some play value to it when not in use as a classroom. It will add an opportunity for the teachers to provide new learning experiences for the students as well as an area for the students to enjoy daily during recess. We also hope to add some bird habitats and butterfly gardens all supplied by the Lake Simcoe Conservation Authority grant.

ESTIMATED COST FOR PHASE 1 \$6800.00

PHASE 2 AND BEYOND

We are currently trying to work out a plan for what type of natural play structures we are allowed and can reasonably afford.

We are working with Natural Playground companies and Lake Simcoe Conservation Authority to come up with a plan to add an outdoor classroom, some wooden play structures and some environmental greening areas. We hope to obtain some grant funding to cover some of the costs. This project will be done over a few years in phases.
